Rules and Instruction for Admission

- All the students qualifying for scholarship shall have to open an account in the bank mentioned by the college authority
- Students getting scholarship from other district and taking admission in the college for further education shall have to submit the "Change of District" certificate issued by the Social Welfare Officer.
- Students with a break in studies should submit a gap certificate in the form of an affidavit stating the reason for the gap.
- Concession /scholarship are based on satisfactory progress regular attendance participation in various college activities and conduct of scholar/student. If he/she failed to show these characteristics, the authority may cancel, stop or withhold the further payments of scholarships.

15. CODE OF CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

"Self-discipline is a best form of discipline" observe it.

- Bills, advertisement or notice cannot be displayed in college premises without permission of the Principal
- "Cleanliness is next to Godness" Cleanliness in the premises at all times must be compulsorily observed. Spitting, littering, Chewing paan/gutka or other intoxicants and smoking is strictly prohibited in college premises. Any infringers will be dealt with severely in accordance with prevailing laws.
- No meetings or programmes should be organized in the college campus without the prior permission of the Principal

- UG students will have to go for medical check-up by the college appointed medical officer and will have to appear for physical efficiency test.
- Notice will be pasted /pinned on the Notice Board and the students themselves should take note of them. Notice will not be circulated in the class-rooms.
- If the student needs information other than given in the prospectus, he should contact the concerned persons in the college office.
- Students are expected not to walk about or make noise in veranda, corridors or lawns when classes are in progress.
- The principal may impose the following punishments in the interest of the students and Institution Fines, cancelling of attendance, withholding of certificates, suspension and expulsion or rustication.
- Students are expected to have regard and consideration to each other and respectfully to the members to the staff.
- The decisions of the college authority regarding extracurricular activities will be final and binding to each student.
- The students should carefully handle the college books, laboratory equipment, lights, fans etc. They should not, in any way cause damage to the college property. In such case he/she will be punished/penalized.
- Without permission of the college authority students/staff member must not provide any information related to the college to the media or any other person/office etc.
- Students are eligible to receive ST Bus/Train concessions have to furnish the correct information. Misuse of this concession is a punishable offence.
- Attendance at the Flag Hoisting Ceremony on Independence Day (15th, August) Republic Day (26th January and Maharashtra Day (1st May) is compulsory.
- Laboratory Aprons shall be worn by the students during practical classes.

- Students should not organize their own picnics, excursion trips etc. Without prior permission to the Principal
- Political movement & violent demonstrations are strictly forbidden in the college campus.

Instruction about Fees and Payment

- Student shall have to pay the fees immediately, as mentioned in the table according to Govt, University & College rules & regulations.
- Refundable fees & other fees not reimbursed by the Govt will be paid by the students
- Students shall have to pay the full fees of the non-granted courses.
- Students who cancel their admission for any reason shall have to pay full fees and other fees for the whole session. The original documents submitted at the time to admission will not be returned back to students at the time of cancellation of admission. It may take some time.
- If the students are getting advantage of ATKT, in such conditions Govt Rule about fees
- (EBC) will be binding on students.
- Student will have to pay all the fees and dues before examination.
- After securing admission in one faculty, if student wants to change the faculty, in such condition he/ she will have to pay admission fee & other fees again.

- Parents should be well aware about their ward's attendance and progress for which they are requested to meet the concerned teacher or Principal for 2-3 times in a year.

Library has Network Resource centre having facilities like E-Journal and E-Books. It is also a member of Inlibnet and N-List.

4) Wi-Fi facility

Students are provided with limited free Wi-Fi facility on the college campus.

5) General Rules

1. Every student has to make an entry in Entry Register.

4. Text books/reference books will be issued to students against Id card.

6) Book Issue

19. RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Read the prospectus carefully for proper information.
2. The last date of submission of application forms will be displayed on the notice board of the college.
3. The selected candidates will have to pay all fees within the prescribed date. In case student does not deposit fees by that date, his/her admission will be treated as cancelled.
4. Students who cancel admission at any time for any reason shall have to pay tuition fees & other fees as per university rules.
5. No certificate of any kind will be issued unless full session fees are paid. Any amount paid by the student at the time of admission and later will not be refunded.
6. **All new entrants will have to enrol themselves in the university. A prescribed form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due course of time or on the date prescribed by the university. Students who fail to fill in the form shall be responsible for any action taken by appropriate authorities.**
7. Students shall have to obey all the instructions of the Principal. They will be answerable to him for their behaviour in general, both inside and outside the college. Students found violating the rules of the college administration or behaving in an indiscipline manner will be expelled from the college. It will be presumed on admission that the students concerned and their parents and/or guardians have read and concurred with these rules.
8. **Students should behave respectfully with all staff members at college and politely with their fellow students, including girls. Any act of disobedience, improper and discourteous exchange of words or indecent remarks, especially at girls students, is a punishable offence and will be viewed seriously.**
9. Students should make careful use of college books, room furniture, fans, laboratory equipment and college property in general. The cost of damage done to it would be recoverable from students either individually or collectively as the case may be.
10. Only special notices shall be read out in the classroom. Students, therefore, should see the notice board daily and keep themselves well informed about the various notices that may be put up there from time to time.

11. No student shall send any information concerning the college for publication either to the press or elsewhere without prior approval of the Principal of college, nor shall he/she approach the president L.M.C. Members except through the college he/she approach the President or the Principal. Any breach of this rule may lead to outright expulsion of the student from the college.

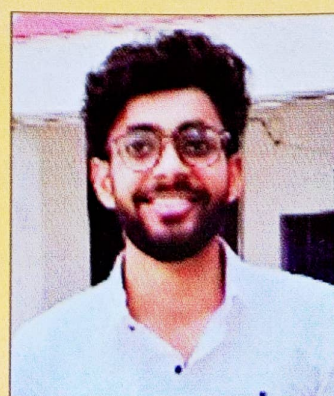

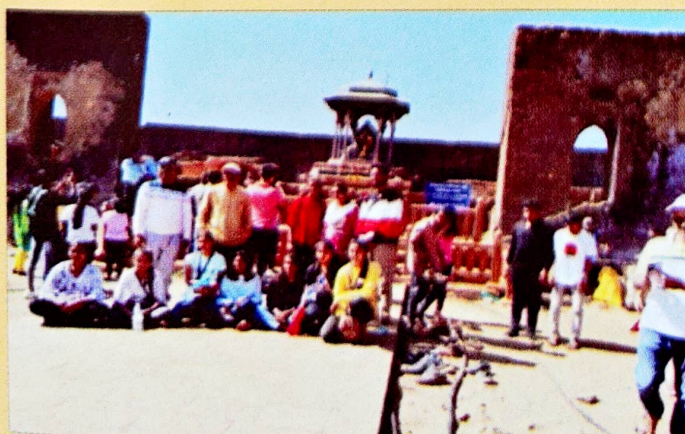


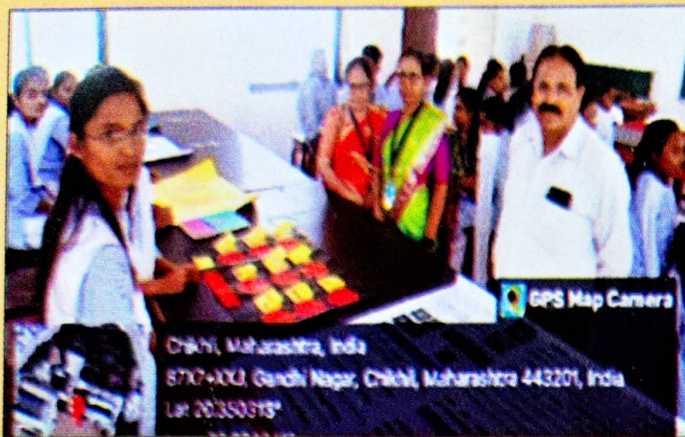
